A Spiritual Government

Step 1. We admit we were powerless over our Government

In a world of resentment magnified into some of the

deadliest atrocities that have ever plagued mankind, the world's five major religions have represented a majority of the earth's population. These have in their own way contributed to the ills facing our planet by causing conflict among individuals and nations. Instead of bringing mankind together as one under the truths that everyone knows exist and each religion hold in common, their definition has done nothing but take from God His infinite existence. It is only by name and actual understanding of God that they differ.

The spiritual principals of right and wrong are the same the world over. Mankind's resentments now become a common denominator in all of these belief systems because his insistence that he is right has made him unable to believe that he may be wrong and given him a perpetual state of ignorance. This intolerance has not allowed all of mankind to live by the Godly principles, but Man cannot know how it would be to live as God would have him it until he actually does so.

Resentment, and all that comes with it, has robbed him of peace, within himself and with others, for he has failed miserably to lead by example or follow the greater examples that have been given to him. The five major religions are:
